



StudentTracker for Outreach Eligibility Requirements

StudentTracker for Outreach can be used to accurately assess the educational achievements of your program participants, and is designed for small, non-profit, organizations that are exclusively working with underserved student populations, as well as federally funded TRIO programs.

You are eligible to participate in StudentTracker for Outreach if ...

Your organization is one of the following federally funded TRIO programs AND serves fewer than 20,000 students per year:

OR

Your organization is an officially recognized tax-exempt, non-profit, that serves 20,000 students or less per year. All students participating in your program should represent one or more underserved student populations (see examples below):

- at-risk youth
- first-generation college students
- individuals with disabilities
- low-income students

AND your organization is not a school, college, or government agency.
