What Is Third-Party Ordering for Admissions?

Third-Party Ordering for Admissions is a service that enables admissions officers, who have a student's signed consent, to order transcripts for their institution's admitted students and applicants. Electronic transcripts are securely delivered to the admissions officer via the Clearinghouse's secure exchange network, ETX Plus, where they can be quickly and easily downloaded.


FERPA Compliance
